Contract Details

Bouygues Construction was awarded the full design & build contract for the New Tyne Crossing in 2007. The Temporary Traffic Management and Lining contract was awarded to Colas Traffic Management from Bouygues Construction; this was won on Price 40% and Quality 60%. The contract started in February 2008 and was completed on 25 November 2011.

Colas managed all aspects of the traffic management from concept, TTRO application and produced all traffic management designs for the project. There were a number of schemes which took place throughout the contract which required the use of Temporary Vertical Concrete Barriers (TVCB) and Water Filled Barriers for extra protection and safety zones to allow works to be carried out.

The works were completed ahead of schedule largely due to good program management, good working relationships and the Traffic Safety & Control Officer's vast experience & knowledge.
