SITE PPE REQUIREMENTS

COLAS

HARD HAT

Compulsory

Hard hats reduce the risk of head injuries and must be worn correctly.

EYE PROTECTION

Compulsory with type determined by risk assessment

Glasses: Used when there is a risk of debris entering the eye. Transparent and tinted versions available.

Goggles: Used where there is a risk of dust, debris or chemicals entering the eye. Hybrid versions available.

Visor: Offers face protection as well as a limited form of eye protection. Normally worn with safety glasses underneath for maximum protection.

HIGH VISIBILITY UPPER

Compulsory

There are a number of different types of garments available to suit all working conditions. Garments are also available in fire retardant variations. Activities that fall under the High Visilibity Policy require a Class 3 garment to be worn.

HIGH VISIBILITY LOWER

Compulsory

When worn correctly, these garments offer you the maximum visibility when working on or near the highway.



HEARING PROTECTION

Determined by risk assessment

Hearing protection protects you against loud and damaging noises that may occur when carrying out certain jobs, provided they are fitted correctly.



GLOVES

Compulsory with type determined by risk assessment

Gloves can protect you from most cuts, abrasions and contact with harmful chemicals provided the right type is selected and worn.



SAFETY BOOTS

Compulsory

The wearing of safety boots is compulsory. Boots not only protect you from the elements, they also offer toe and sole protection.



Where highways, airfields, construction or other related work activities are undertaken, the company policy is that the following must be worn:

Class 3 high visibility yellow long sleeve vest **or** Class 3 high visibility yellow long sleeve jacket **or** Class 3 high visibility yellow long sleeve polo shirt.

With

Class 1 high visibility yellow trousers.

This requirement applies to anyone on our sites including inspectors, clients and other visitors.
